1. Buryat ASSR: Barguzinskii Raion (centre of study selo Bayangol)
 2. Buryat ASSR: Zhidinskii Raion (centre of study Petropavlovka)
 3. Chita Oblast: Borzya (centre of study)
 4. Tuva ASSR: Ovyurskii Raion (centre of study Khundaratal) *selo*
 5. Mongolia: Uvs-nuur Aimak (centre of study Bvd Semen, or ~~tribe~~ *bi* ~~coff~~ Achit Nur, Uvs Nuur, and Khar Uls Nuur)
 6. Mongolia: Khubsugul Aimak (centre of study region to west of Lake Khubsugul)
 7. Mongolia: Dornod Aimak (centre of study to east of Lake Hulun)

We would like to order photographs of the above places taken as far as possible at the earliest year (1979), the latest year (1991) and one year in the middle (1985). Three dates.

We would also like to order, if possible, the above photographs taken in spring and ~~autumn~~ *summer*. Two seasons.

- B) Black and white air mapping photographs (high resolution prints)
1. Buryat ASSR: Barguzinskii Raion (Bayangol selsovet, Kurumkan selsovet)
 2. Buryat ASSR: Zhidinskii Raion (Petropavlovka and nearby pastoral region)
 3. Chita Oblast: Novaya Zarya selsovet

If possible we would like these photographs at 10 year intervals. As far as possible they should be overlapping to allow stereoscopic interpretation. The scale: 1: 30,000 if possible
